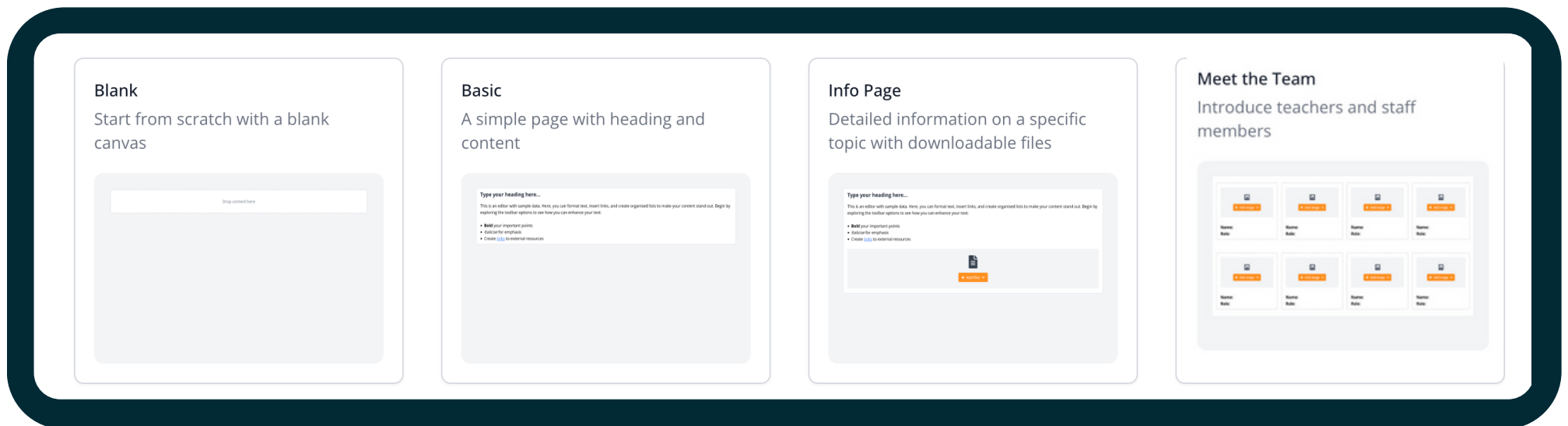

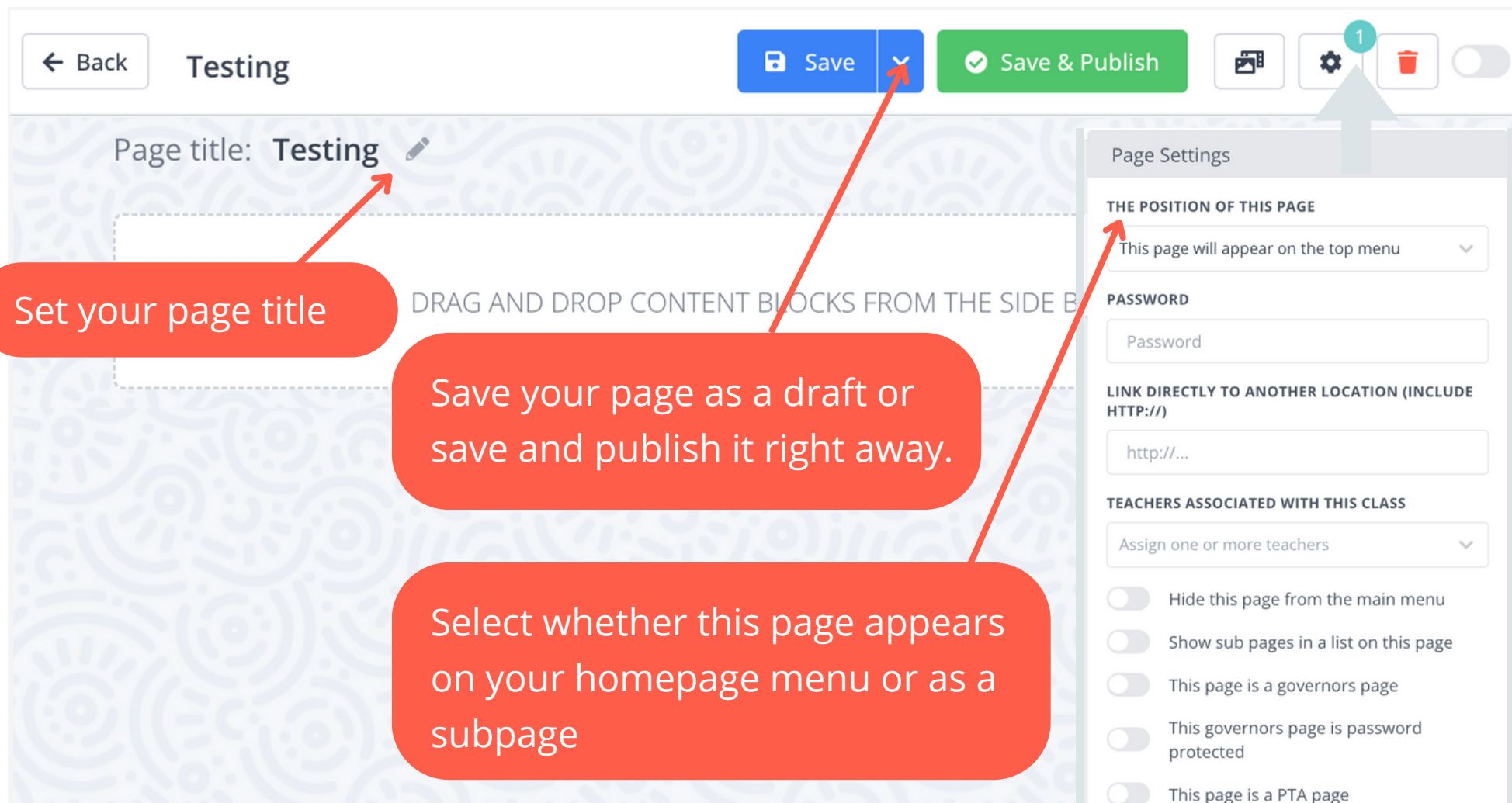
# Select a template

When you are building a new page, select **+new and** give your page a title. Then, you can choose a template or a blank page.

All templates are editable, but give you a format to work with to add your content. Using the blank option means you can build the page completely from scratch.

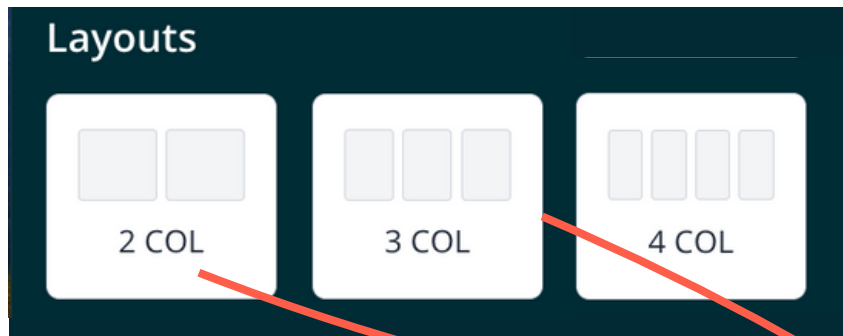

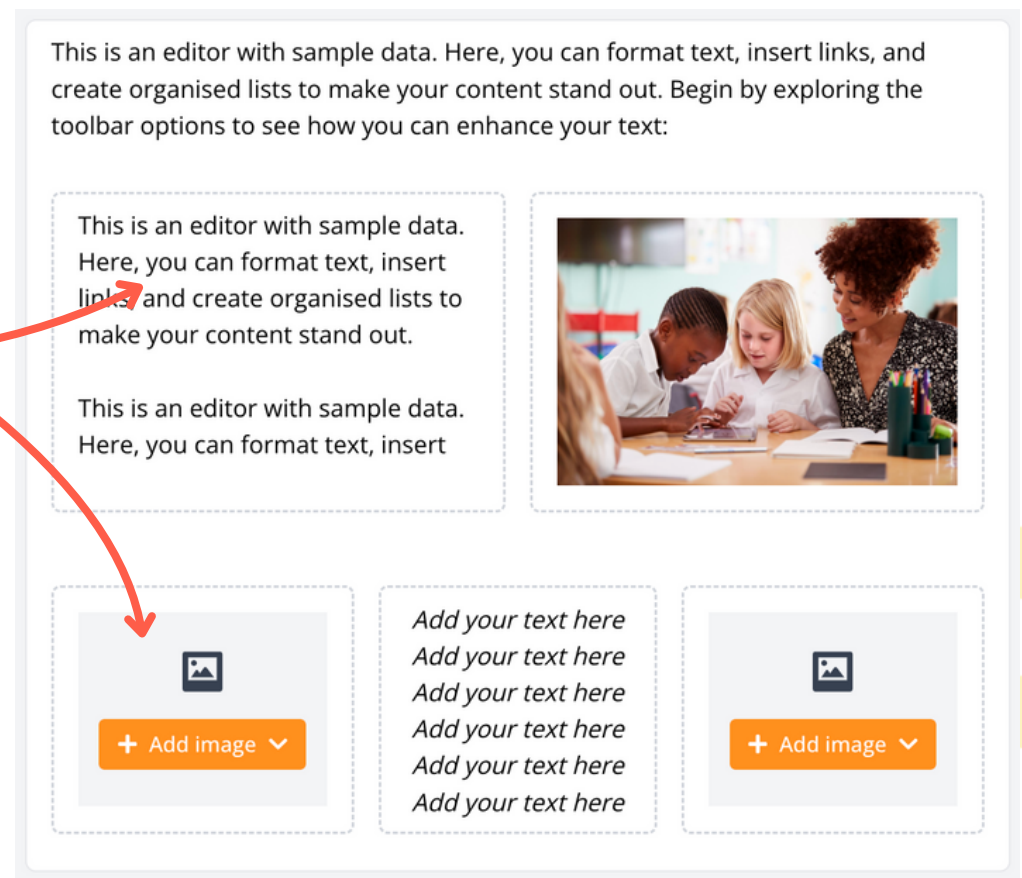
# Page layouts

In order for your pages to work across all devices, your content must be organised into columns. Use the standard one column or select a 2,3 or 4 to build your page layout.



Drag your **column blocks** onto the page to begin building a layout.

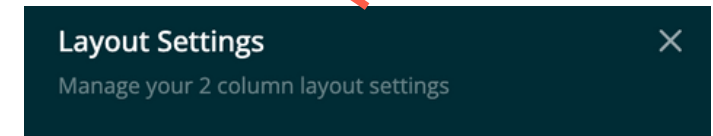
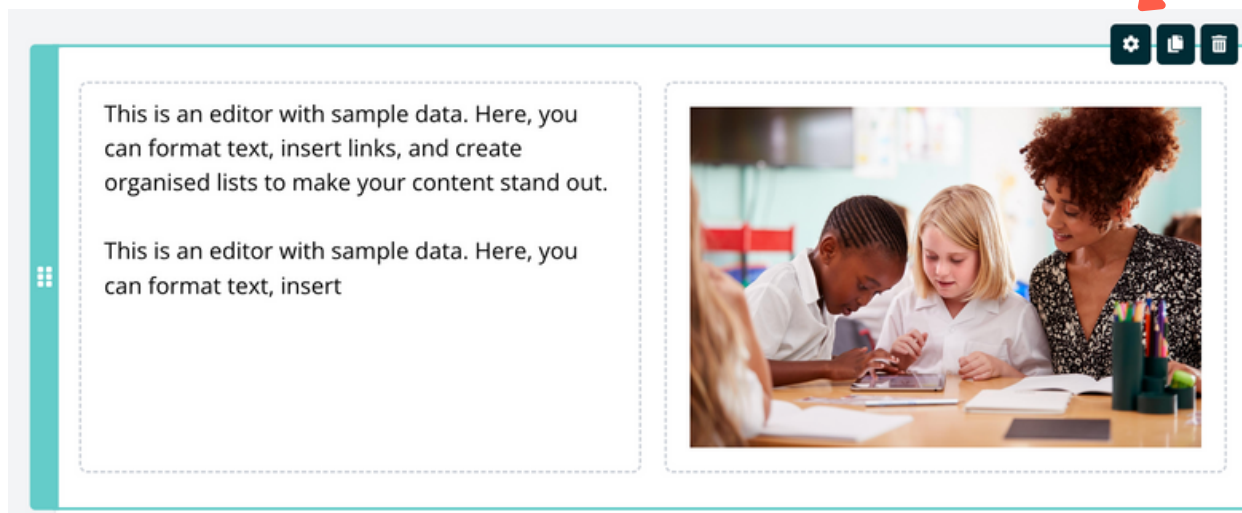
If you drag **content blocks** straight into the area, it will be a ONE column layout which means the content is all 100% width of the screen.



## Column settings

If you want to change the ratio of your columns to further manage the layout, you can use a 2 column layout and select the different ratios to format the page further.

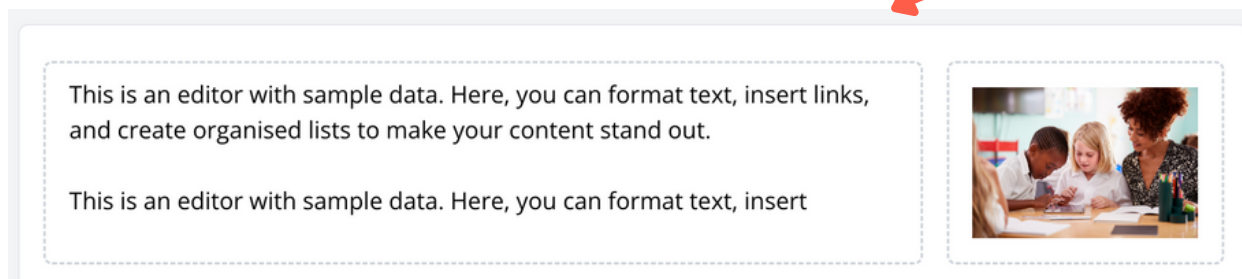

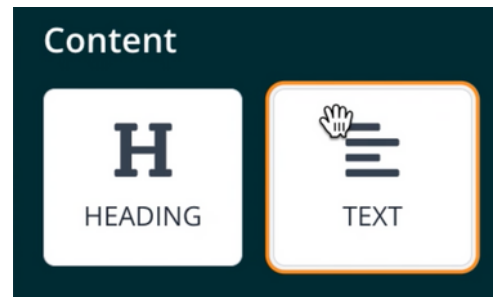


Tip: Not all columns need content, you can use the layouts to create space to the right/left of content.

# Adding your content

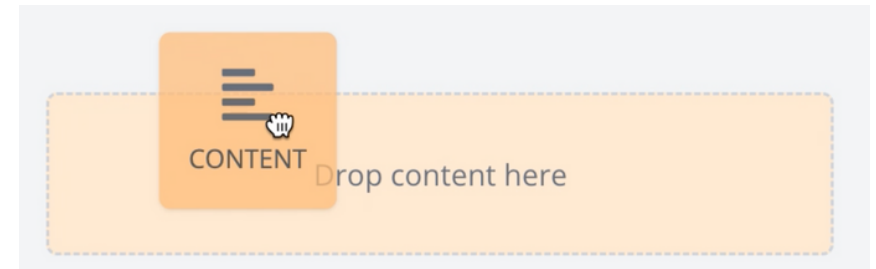
Once you have your layout blocks, or if you are sticking to a single column then you can start dragging in your content blocks from the left hand menu.

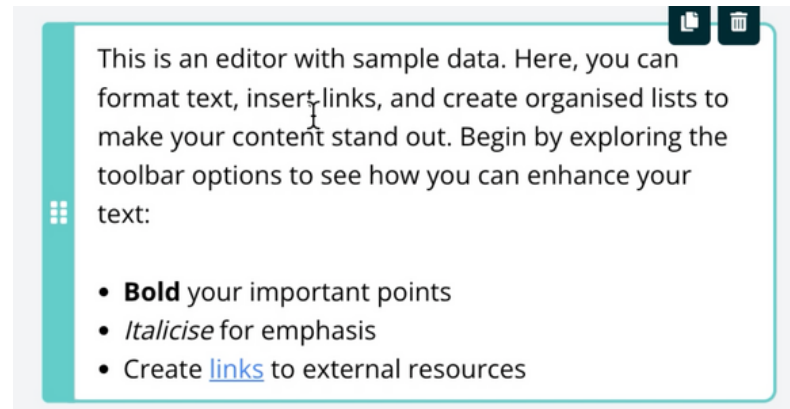
*Select content block*

*Hold and drag to chosen column (you can move them if you need to)*

*Drop the block and click into the area to begin editing or adding media*

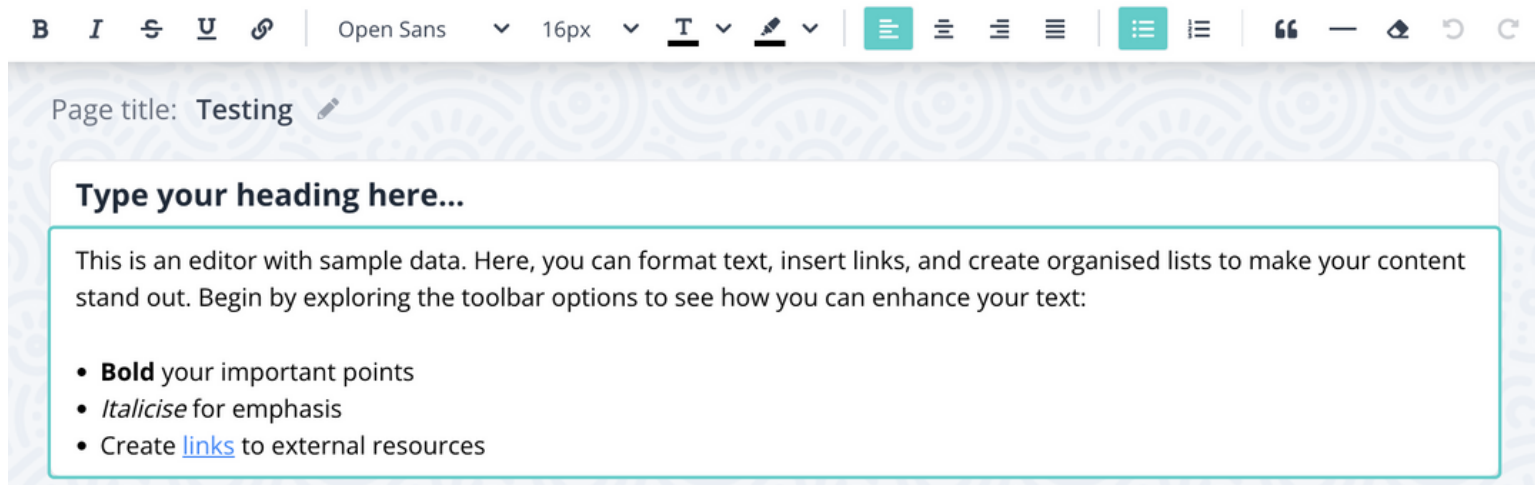


The blue outline will show around the content or layout block you are editing. You can press and hold  to move the block or the full column to another location or click the settings cog for more options.



## Headings and text

When adding text blocks, you will have a banner of text formatting options. Use this the same way you would a word document.



Use this to add bigger and bolder headings in your text



This is for your standard text blocks.

Use the headings setting cog for more options for your headings, these are all preset during your website design build. For example: **H2** **H3** H4

## Media - Images

### Image

Single images can be added to your page which is great to break up text. The image width will always be the width of the column you add it to, so it will be a full screen image on a single column.



### Gallery

Add multiple images to create a gallery of photos. These will be automatically sized to a thumbnail which can be expanded on click, viewed and scrolled through.



### Carousel

Add multiple images that automatically scroll through. The carousel is best with landscape images only as it is cropped into a banner sized container.

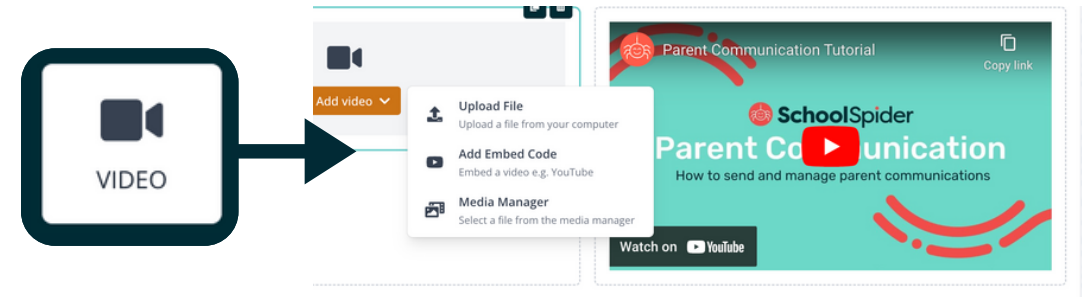




## Additional media

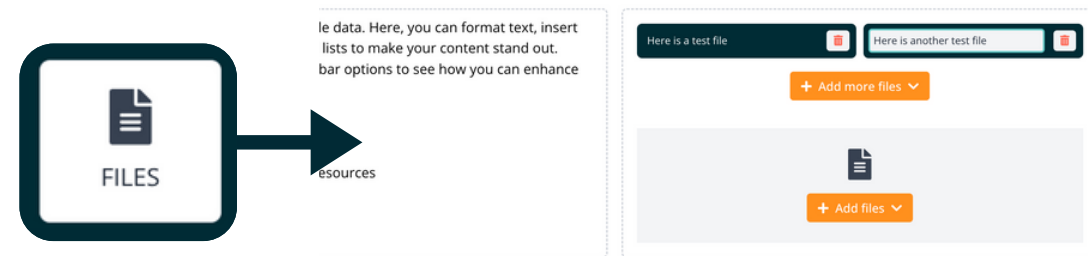
### Video

You can upload a video via a file from your computer or an embed code which you can find on videos on YouTube and other applications.



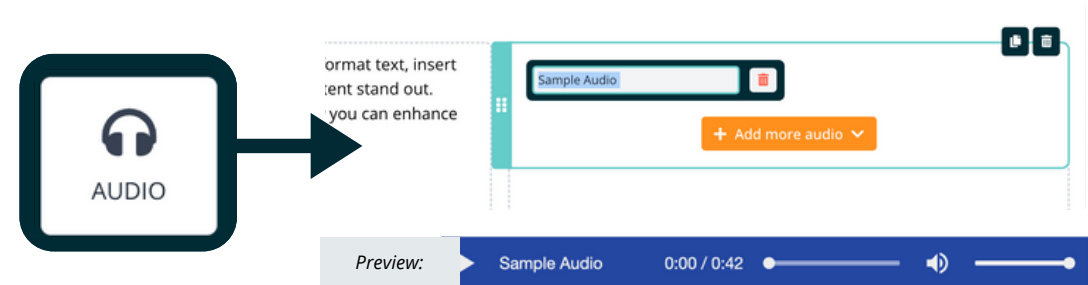
### Files

You can add file blocks anywhere in your layout. Add one or multiple files by selecting them from your computer. Double click the name to rename your file.



### Audio

You can add audio files such as MP3's the same way you add files. These will appear as the preview shows, in line with your schools colours.

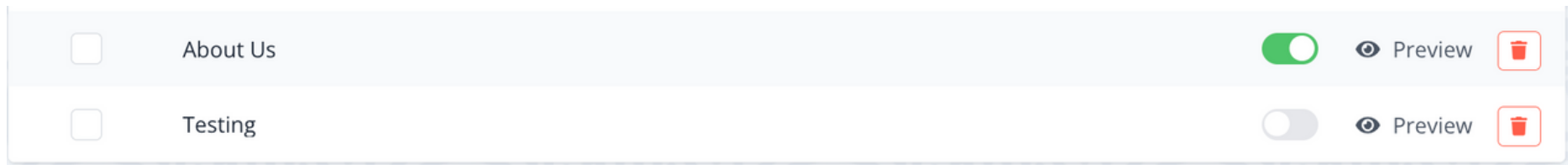


# Saving and publishing

If you need to leave mid way through editing or you want to preview your page before publishing then you can do this by saving as a draft first.



Select the blue save button to create a draft/unpublished page, or you can save and publish right away. Remember when editing a current page, you **must always save** before exiting for your updates to publish.



Go to your page list to preview a page by selecting the preview button. You can also make pages active (*published*) by selecting the toggle to go green.
